

CHEAT SHEET OF STANDARDS


There are standards too numerous to mention here that have proven to make a room feel comfortable if followed. Interior designers use these standards to design spaces. These standards can easily be looked up on the internet.

Balancing form and function – style, color, furniture, lighting

LIVING ROOM/FAMILY ROOM

Spacing

- The arms of the furniture pieces do not overlap when placed at right angles to each other.
- In a conversation area the seating from seat back to seat back does not go beyond 9' for comfortable conversation
- There is about 2 inches between sofa and side table is comfortable.
- There is about 12" between chair and ottoman as a comfortable distance to walk between and still put your feet up comfortably.
- Placed two chairs 24" apart to allow for a small table in between and 12" apart if side by side with no small table in between



- All pathways are 36" through the space and 48" wide for pathways where 2 or more people need to pass comfortably.
- The transition zone at doorways is clear of furniture
- Coffee table is placed 18" away from sofa or chairs for comfortable reach and walking

Chairs and Sofas come in a variety of sizes

Typically 60"-90 " long
72" sofa sits 2 people
84" seats 2 people comfortably or 3 friends
96" seats 3
108" seats 3 comfortably or 4
120" seats 4 comfortably
38" deep

36-42 + 72 = 108-114

Sectional Lengths and Widths

Typical length 108-168 is typical Small Sectional 90-114 Mid-size 114-138 typical length Large size 138-168 typical length

34-40" typical overall **sofa depth from front to back**. Seat depth will be less than this, typically 20-24". Shorter people will want a smaller seat depth and longer legs will want closer to 24"

Cozy Arm Chairs Length and Width

Typical 36-36" depth and width

Slipper Chair Length and Width

22" wide by 27 deep

Coffee Table Length and Width

Coffee table length = 2/3 sofa length
Table depth = typically 18-28"
36-42" diameter is typical for round coffee tables

Accessory Tables Length and Width

22" wide by 24" deep

Bookshelf Length and Width

12-16" deep by 24" or greater wide

TV Distance from Viewer

TV size appropriate for room size – viewing distanc



How to Identify and Create an Ideal Layout for Each Room in Your Home



Best to view the TV at the same height as the viewer. Optimum viewing angle is within 45 degrees to the left of center and to the right of center. If the seating is beyond 45 degrees from center, consider adding an arm to angle the TV toward the viewer.

Furniture Heights

Sofa Heights

34-38" typical sofa back height for 8' rooms

Sofa arm height is typically 23-26"

Typical sofa seat height 16-20".

Cozy Arm Chairs

Again, typical chair seat height is 16-20"

16-18" typical height of ottoman which is just shy of chair seat height.

Coffee Table

15-18" typical height

Should be the same height as chair/sofa seat height +-2"



If serving tea or food +2-4" or as high as +3-6"

Accessory Tables

Ideally side tables should be equal to or slightly higher than the sofa arm. It isn't ideal but it can be slightly lower.

8-10" above chair seat if armless

Additional Seating

Wall seating

Double duty seating – DR chairs are narrower than LR Side tables can become seats. Footstools, bench

Storage

Rug

Furniture should sit on the rug

Place whole room rugs 6-12" from walls

Artwork

- should be hung at eye level (around 5'4")
- Hang picture 6-8 " above sofa to show a relationship to the sofa.
- Ideal width is 2/3 width of sofa beneath it
- Picture width or grouping of pictures width = 2/3 width of wall or related furniture piece
- Center picture height or total height of grouping of pictures 60" from floor.
- Artwork relating to another piece below it is hung no higher than 6" away from the related piece

Lighting

Lamp Shade

- Height of table lamp shade = 1/2 height of lamp base (not including socket cap) or 1/3 of total lamp height
- Lamp shade diameter = 2 times the widest point in base or 2" +/- of lamp base height

- Reading light bottom of lamp shade should be at eye level when sitting in chair or bed
- Lamp shade diameter must be smaller than the table its on

Lamp Base

• Lamp height/table height = no more than 1.5:1

Ceiling Fixture

- Width of Light fixture over table = 2/3 table width
- Bottom of hanging light fixture be at least 7' from the floor when walking underneath it.
- Bottom of chandelier at 78" from floor or higher


Have soft light behind the screen or in the same room if watching in a dark room.


• Have soft light behind the screen or in the same room if watching in a dark room. Have option to soften light from outside to avoid glare on the screen.

Curtains

- If using draperies, place furniture from wall with clearance of curtain depth. Curtains will close behind furniture.
- Curtain rod length = window opening width x 1.3
- Curtain Fullness 1.5 to 2 times the curtain rod length
- Curtains should be installed above the top of window frame and as close to the ceiling to increase visual height
- Curtains should barely touch the floor

For our living room example, we will refer to at least these 3 standards to help when placing furniture.

You may not have to walk around them but they stop the eye from moving past it.

BED ROOM

Spacing and Clearances

- 30-36" around bed for clearance.
- 36" wide walk ways
- There is about 2 inches between bed and side table is comfortable.
- There is about 12" between chair and ottoman as a comfortable distance to walk between and still put your feet up comfortably.
- Placed two chairs 24" apart to allow for a small table in between and 12" apart if side by side with no small table in between.


Bed Calculator Tool

TO Calculate bed size

Width of room – 60-72" (clearance on 2 sides of bed) = bed size

Bed against wall Width of room – 30-36"(clearance on 1 side of bed) = bed size




- All pathways are 36" through the space and 48" wide for pathways where 2 or more people need to pass comfortably.

Bed height 18-20" or 22-24" Continental beds 30" high

Nightstand should be close to the same height as the top of your mattress

Storage

Length of longest garment
Hangers are 16-18" wide and need 24" depth closet
Allow 4" for each coat and 12" for each hat
Coat hook 60-70" from floor
Children's coat hook 37-39" from floor
Men's shoes 12 ½" deep shelf

Styling

Artwork

Artwork should be hung at eye level (around 5'4")

Curtains

Curtains should be installed above the top of window frame and 1.3 times the width of the window opening

Curtains should barely touch the floor

Rug

Entire bed and night stands should sit on the rug

*alternatively, the rug doesn't have to go under night stands but at least 24" wider on each side so you step onto the rug from the bed

Do not have rug end in the middle of a pathway. Either have it end at the foot or extend 36" over the pathway.

24-30" beyond the foot of the bed

Lighting

Bottom of hanging light fixture be at least 7' from the floor when walking underneath it. Light source should be 8" outside of mattress and 24" above mattress height



How to Identify and Create an Ideal Layout for Each Room in Your Home

Have soft light behind the screen or in the same room if watching in a dark room. Have option to soften light from outside to avoid glare on the screen.

Shade Width – 2 times lamp base width is traditional

Lamp base width – the wider the bed the wider the bedside lamp should be. 1/3 size of bedside table width

Total lamp height = approximately the same height as bedside table

Bedroom Light – soft, warm like 2700-2800 K in color & 200-400 lumens in brightness

Bedside Table

Styling Bedside Table – Lamp needs to be within reach from sitting on bed. Sometimes this means moving it to the inside. In addition to the lamp you may want to add....

Option 1 - Small plant and clock is a typical 3. Other side can be a small box and book on top.

Option 2 – small picture and low bowl

Option 3 – flower in bud vase and horizontal book

Option 4 - Candle and small saucer

Styling Bedside Table with no lamp – Either have a single stacked grouping or a grouping of 3.

Option 1 – Stacked books with a small plant on top

Option 2 – Small plant with a book laying down with a small clock on top

Option 3 – Picture frame, small plant and horizontal book

Option 4 – Tray with plant, candle and small box

Bookcase

Styling a Bookcase – Framed photos (vertical, horizontal, small, medium, large), trays, vases (all shapes, sizes, shapes, textures), dried and fresh florals & greens, books (all sizes) preferably neutral colors, plants, sculptural elements (different shapes, sizes and textures), large stand-alone items that look good all by themselves (basket, bowl, box, vase)

Option 1 – large tray or picture in back and tall vase and small candle in front creating a grouping of 3

Option 2 - single large item

Option 3 – Grouping of books with horizontal box on one side



Option 4 - Grouping of books between bookends acting as a singular element

Option 5 – Singular basket with small items inside

Option 6 – Stacked Boxes graduating smaller on top



HALLWAY

Spacing and Clearances

36" wide walk ways 48" walk way to allow 2 people to pass easily Allow 36" diameter inside entry to allow room to put on coat

Sizing

Console Table sizes can vary 12-16" depth by 30-72" long Runners approximately 2/3 width of hallway and stairs

Furniture Heights

Place low <u>seat</u> 37-39"

<u>Console Table</u> Height can vary 30-45"

Storage

LENGTH OF LONGEST GARMENT
Hangers are 16-18" wide and need 24" depth closet
Allow 4" for each coat and 12" for each hat
Children's coat hook 37-39" from floor
Men's shoes 12 ½" deep shelf
Place hook or hat shelf 71" from floor
Place coat hooks 60-70" from floor

Styling



KITCHEN

Spacing and Clearances

36"-44.5" wide walk ways

48" walk way to allow 2 people to pass easily

32-47" surface between sink and oven

18-20" distance between countertop and upper cabinets

Surface needed next to refrigerator and ovens

Need 47" clearance to open oven doors

Avoid dishwasher door opening into walkway that is often used

44 ½ walkway is sufficient

Ideally 1 ½ steps between sink, refrigerator and stove

Work surface between sink and oven 32-47" wide

2 work surfaces opposite one another requires 47" wide and preferably 55" wide to have 2 people work at the same time

11-12" leg clearance between chair top and bottom of table apron

<u>Light switch clearance</u> – A minimum of 5 feet is required between water source and light switch

Furniture Heights

Finished Bar Height 42" from the floor Finished Counter Height 36" from the floor Bar height stool height varies 28-32" Counter height stool height varies 24 - 27"



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

BATHROOM

All circuits must be protected by GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters).

Spacing and Clearances

<u>Shower</u> - No less than 36" by 36" shower is recommended <u>Toilet Paper Holder</u> - 26-30" above floor and reachable from toilet 30" clearance in front of sink

<u>Light switch clearance</u> – A minimum of 5 feet is required between water source and light switch <u>Bathtub</u> – A 21"-30" clearance is needed to the nearest fixture from the bathtub

Grab Bar - 34-36" above the floor

<u>Toilet</u> – 30" from the front of toilet & 15" from center of the toilet on each side

Shower Door – must open outward

<u>Double Sink</u> – 30"-36" between center of 2 sinks

Sizing

A standard bathroom door is 32 inches 80" shower door 78-86 %" shower curtain rod Standard shower curtain is 72" tall by 78" wide or 72x72 $\underline{Bathtub} - Standard \ bathtub \ is \ 60" \ x \ 30"$

Sink Base – vary in width but minimum 30" width

Fixture Heights

<u>Vanity</u> – standard height is 30" high and 24" deep but can be higher for comfort



18" hand towel hook above countertop 39-47" small towel hooks from floor 59-63" large towel hooks from floor Towel Bar average height is 48" from floor Child's height for towel is 36" from floor

<u>Light fixtures</u> need to be suitable for wet environment.

Spacing and Clearances

<u>Table Size</u> is dependent on #people to be seated (see chart) *Eating Area Needed*


Well.... This depends. Some gatherings of close friends and family can feel comfortable with 18" space per diner but standard would be closer to a Minimum Eating Area Size = 24"wide by 12" deep


Less than 48" table width does not allow a diner at the ends of the table.



Walkways

30-36" wide walk ways needed around table to nearest obstruction but tight 48" walk way clearance is better to allow for walking behind a seated person No walkway like in the case of a kitchen nook where one slides in on a bench, only the seat depth is required for the distance between the table and the wall.

Chair

11-12" leg clearance between chair top and bottom of table apron

Standard arm Height would be 23" for a standard 30" table without an apron. If there is an apron on the table, lower the arm height or choose chairs without arms.

Table standard height is 30" *Take note if there is an apron which will affect the arm height of the chair.

Dining Room Chairs

Standard dining room *chair width* is 16-20" but allow at least 30" in width for each person sitting at the table. For Tighter seating, you can allow 24".

Artwork should be hung at eye level (around 5'4")

- If using draperies, place furniture from wall with clearance of curtain depth. Curtains will close behind furniture.
- Curtain rod length = window opening width x 1.3
- Curtain Fullness

- Curtains should barely touch the floor

Rug

Rug should be large enough so that the chairs pulled out will still sit on the rug. This is no less than 30" larger than the table size.

Rug 24"-30" beyond on sides

Lighting



<u>Ceiling Light Fixture -</u> Bottom of hanging light fixture be at least 7' from the floor when walking underneath it.

Lighting

36" distance is typical for the bottom of a hanging light fixture to the table top.

<u>Décor</u>

Keep your centerpiece lower than 15" so that diners can see across the table to the other diners.



Leave room in front of the washer 59" why?

Allow 24-30" clearance above top loading washer

Washer – Standard size 27 wide by 32-34" deep

Dryer – 27" wide x

<u>Top Load Washer and Dryer</u> – standard size is 27" wide by 27-28" deep

Stackable Washer and Dryer -

Washer - 39" height


